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Cumberland is component of the big Whitsunday Island chain, and its crown jewel is undoubtedly Hayman Island, dwelling to the Hayman resort.

For families planning a trip to Disney World, a major factor to look at is whether to stay on property at a Disney owned hotel or remain off property.

I must admit to being a huge fan of staying on property, in fact, I've a major bias in that direction. There is one thing comforting about being in a secure little Disney bubble. It is familiar. It is convenient.

There are, however, other additional tangible perks to staying on property that you simply really should think about before making a final decision:

First constructed in the 1950s by Reg Ansett, Hayman Resort is the quintessential tourist attraction of the chain and of the 400 hectares of Hayman Island, the resort's buildings and activity places covers practically every small thing but the beautiful beaches.

Of course, the actual resort is not that large, but after factoring within the several tour zones, diverse retail stores, golf courses and other sporting zones, the entire Hayman Island seems to be 1 giant resort. The location of the island itself is near perfection. When Ansett set out to decide on his location for constructing a resort, he had carte blanche to opt for any island in the Whitsunday chain. He ultimately settled on Hayman.

- **Extra Magic Hours** - Extra Magic hours provide you with added time inside the parks. At least 1 park a day will either open one hour early or stay open 3 hours late for resort guests. While the park with the Extra Magic hours inside the morning tends to be a good deal busier the complete day, the evening Extra Magic hours don't tend to draw the similar crowds. If you have a Park Hopper ticket, it could possibly be a good plan to take benefit of the early opening at 1 park and then move on to a less crowded park for the remainder of one's day.
- **Disney's Magical Express** - The Magical Express is among the very best offers around. You say goodbye to your luggage at your local airport (hopefully for only several hours!) and hop on an Orlando bound plane. When you land, just follow the indicators to the Magical Express buses, check in, and also you is going to be whisked away to your hotel. No baggage claim or automobile rental necessary. Your bags will magically seem in your room a couple of hours later! Just remember to carry on anything that you simply consider you may well want within some hours of landing... crucial medications, park tickets, sunscreen, comfy park clothes or a bathing suit would all be excellent choices!
- **Free Parking** - All resort guests can self park free at resorts and parks. If you drove your very own car, or rented 1 when you arrived, you can save \$14 per day in parking fees by staying on property. If staying off property, be certain to add your hotel's parking fee, if any, to your theme park parking totally free to obtain your total everyday parking fee.
- **Advanced Dining Reservations** - As a Disney resort guest you get an additional perk when generating your ADR's. Disney calls this the 180 day +10 plan. This can give you a 190 day window for some reservations - a HUGE advantage if you're trying to book the tough to get Le Cellier or Cinderella's Royal Table!
- **Disney Transportation** - Disney transportation is really pretty cool. Yes, sometimes there might be very a wait should you are coming or going at a busy time. And there is definitely nothing a lot more frustrating that watching a loaded bus take off for the Magic Kingdom just as you breathlessly arrive at the bus stop! Overall, Disney transportation is a good thing. It is amazingly efficient, free, and will get you exactly where you have to have to go in a reasonably timely fashion. Put away your road maps and don't worry about telling each 1 within your party where you parked in hopes *someone* will remember. Just hop on a bus, boat, or monorail, relax and review the very first couple of objects in your touring plan so you might be prepared to hit the ground running whenever you arrive!
- **Key to the World Card** - Is it a room key? A park ticket? It is so good to have everything on 1 card. Also, it can be an excellent thought to have a "Keeper of the cards" in your party. Hand over your card right after you enter the turnstile and then send that particular person off at a brisk pace to obtain a Fastpass for every person within the group while every person else walks at a relaxed pace to the initial attraction.
- **Package Delivery** - No need to have to haul your purchases about the parks all day or be concerned about

how you are going to preserve your newly bought goodies dry as you zoom down Kali River Rapids. Just ask that your package be delivered to your resort gift shop. No fuss no muss!

- **Dining Plan** - If you purchased a package deal for your travel, you may have the alternative of taking benefit of the Dining Plan (or it's Quick Service and Deluxe) cousins. The dining strategy is straightforward to have an understanding of and is extremely convenient. If you might be smart about how you spend your credits, it is going to also save you a great deal of money. It is also great to have a pretty beneficial thought of what your food fees shall be prior to you ever arrive.
- **Refillable Mugs** - If you are a Coke addict...and I do mean the cola...then a refillable mug might be correct up your alley. Purchase a mug at your resort for about \$14 and you can get as many refills *at your resort* as you wish. Grab a drink as you head out to the parks for the day and another once you come in for a break, and by all indicates bring that mug with you once you head out to the pool! The longer your stay, the much more price helpful your mug will be. Now you may have an excuse to remain a number of much more days! The finest aspect about the refillable mug is that it can be will fit nicely within your suitcase and will bring back all of the fond memories of your trip every time you use it.
- **It is affordable...or not!** - If you should adhere to a strict spending budget or for those who have saved for a splurge there is seriously a hotel for you.
- **Child Care** - It's a vacation for Mom and Dad, too! It can be a bit expensive, but can you seriously place a value on a romantic stroll around the World Showcase following Illuminations? Or a peaceful and fairly dinner at Victoria and Albert's? It is going to be a fun night for all.
- **Freedom to separate** - Your child may possibly be old sufficient to do some exploring on their own, but not old adequate to drive your rental car. Your toddler may possibly require a nap, but your older child is just *dying* to see the parade. Staying on property and making use of Disney transportation makes it possible for everybody inside your group to come and go as they please.
- **It is just cool.** - Enough said!
