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Bridesmaids gifts are a great way to say thank you to your bridesmaids for supporting you on your wedding day. But is presenting your bridesmaids the [wedding jewelry](#) you intend for them to use on big day as their bridesmaid present the smart thing to do?

If money was no concern then yes wouldn't it be nice to give your bridesmaids jewellery to wear at the wedding and an extra to show your thanks at the reception but that's not always possible. So to help you with this problem there are a few questions you should ask yourself.

At a relative's wedding, did the bride give their bridesmaids jewellery to wear on the day as their present or did they buy another gift to give to them at the reception?

If the majority of your friends or relatives gave their bridesmaids jewellery for them to wear at the wedding as their present then you should be ok doing the same. If any of your bridesmaids are married and they gave their bridesmaids additional presents then you may need to as well.

Is the [wedding jewellery](#) wearable again, not just at other special occasions but for more casual wear?

If the answers are yes, then it's acceptable to give wedding jewelry as the bridesmaid present. But if you think that there is very little chance of them being able to use it again or it isn't their normal taste, get them a second bridesmaid present, something that they will enjoy. Remember a gift doesn't mean anything if there's no thought behind it.

Will the men from the wedding party be wearing / using their wedding presents during the day?

If the men in the wedding party are also wearing or using their wedding present during the wedding day then it's fine to expect the same of the bridesmaids. Make sure there are no double standards though, if you've given the best man and ushers something for the day and then give them an extra present at the reception then you should be doing it for the bridesmaids too. If you've already bought your bridesmaids high quality wedding jewellery which they are likely to wear again then show your appreciation at the wedding reception by getting them a less expensive gift but something with a little thought behind it.

Do I have the cash to give my bridesmaids wedding jewellery plus another gift?

When it comes to weddings, money places huge limitations on your choices so if money is a concern either give your bridesmaids wedding jewellery which can be reused and acknowledge their support on your big day with something that doesnt cost a lot for example poem created specifically for them to show how much theyre appreciated. Or opt for simple and less expensive wedding jewellery such as a crystal pendant and use the money you were planning on spending on another present.

If your budget cant stretch to wedding jewelry and an extra bridesmaid present but youre worried that your bridesmaids are wanting this, then dont be afraid to tell them theres just not enough money in the [budget]wedding budget. If they dont like this then maybe you should repick your bridesmaids.

Depending on the social norms that work within your family and circle of friends will give you an indication whether you can give your bridesmaids wedding jewelry as their gifts or not, this is also influenced by whether the men in the wedding party will be receiving additional gifts.

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
